### Position Summary

The Alliance for Innovation and Infrastructure (Aii) seeks a proactive Public Policy Analyst to support our research and educational mission.

Responsibilities include public policy research into an array of innovation- and infrastructure-related topics. Day-to-day tasks may include qualitative and quantitative analysis, survey design, reading academic literature and proposed legislation, writing reports and policy blogs, and collaborating to pursue new areas of research and education. Aii focuses on topics related to climate and conservation, damage prevention, eminent domain, energy infrastructure, innovation and technology, and transportation infrastructure.

The ideal candidate will be highly organized, research- and task-oriented, and able to collaborate remotely. We are looking for someone who is intellectually curious, able to manage multiple projects, and meet deadlines. The candidate should be nonpartisan or able to critically evaluate all aspects of a given policy. This role reports directly to the Director of Public Policy.

### Minimum Qualifications

- Four-year undergraduate degree in Political Science, Business, Public Administration, Economics, Pre-Law, or similar field
- Strong research skills
- Strong writing and editing skills

### Preferred Qualifications

- Experience with grants (identifying, writing, or executing)
- Quantitative research skills
- Experience on Capitol Hill
- Knowledge and interest in law and public policy
- A record of published work
